D. LT COL KELLY WARNED THEM THAT THEY SHOULD HAVE SECURITY PERSONNEL
WITH THEM. HE OFFERED TO PROVIDE USMC SECURITY. THEY REFUSED THE OFFER.

E .ALL SIX USAF PERONNEL WERE IN ONE CLOSED TOP 1 4 TON TRUCK.

F. THEYTOOKTHE 1/4TON TRUCK FROM USAF RESOURCES AT DONG HA WITHOUT OBTAINING PERMISSION TO DO SO. G. THEY WERE APPARENTLY AMBUSHED BY VC. ALL WERE KILLED. TWO BODIES WERE FOUND IN THE VEHICLE . THE VEHICLE WAS BURNED BY THE VC.

M. ALL MEN HAD BEEN SHOT IN THE HEAD AFTER THE JEEP WAS STOPPED BY GRENADE (S) AND THE MEN SHOT, EVIEDENTLY, BY CARBINES.
